

Ballet Flamenco La Rosa celebrates its 30th with 'El Padre'



Swedish dancer Josefine Chiachiero will perform in Ilisa Rosal's 'El Padre' at Miami-Dade County Auditorium.

Celebrating its 30th anniversary, Ballet Flamenco La Rosa will present the world premiere of *El Padre (The Father)*, a flamenco ballet the company's artistic director, Ilisa Rosal. Based on the play by August Strindberg, tells the story of a man manipulated by his wife, who tries to have him committed so she can gain control of their fortune and their daughter.

Rosal will perform in the piece, which has music and lyrics by Antonio Gabarri and Nieves Diaz. Eloy Aguilar plays the Father, Spanish artist Carmela Greco his scheming wife. Swedish artist Josefine Chiachiero is among the guest artists in a production featuring nine dancers and five musicians.
